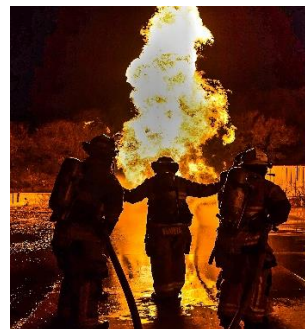
Fire Investigation: First Responders

Curriculum: Fire Investigation

This two-day course presents a basic overview of a fire investigation. The course will stress the importance of fire scene awareness, evidence identification, preservation, and the basics of a fire investigation. Students will develop an appreciation of the convergence of suppression, investigation, science, and law.
